产品简介:

蓝牙音乐接收器(免提)是一款可以接收手机或者有蓝牙功能的发射器上的音乐的高科技无线产品。此款音乐接收器几乎可以用于所有的音频接收器输入插头即可,包括汽车装置。可以在家里的音响或者是车载的音响系统接收到从你的手机和 MP3 接收到的音乐。享受至尊车载音乐、通话解决方案,利用智能手机通过车载音响拨打电话和欣赏音乐。轻轻一按即可免提通话、欣赏储存在电话中的音乐甚至播放 Internet 广播。该产品带有嵌入式回音消除麦克风, 只用一个按钮即可轻松地在音乐与电话间切换。

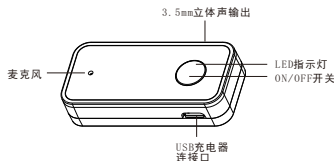

产品概观



充电

1. 使用提供的 USB 线的一端连接到此款蓝牙音乐接收器的 mini-USB 输入接口
2. 将 USB 线的另一端连接到您的电脑、笔记本或者 USB 功率转换器, 这时蓝牙音乐接收器的 LED 灯变红,表示正在充电。
3. 当充电结束,红色的 LED 灯将会熄灭。满电情况下可以提供长达 8 小时播放时间。

配对

1. 进入配对模式, 长按开关按钮 5 秒钟直到红色和蓝色 LED 灯同时闪烁。
2. 在您的手机或者相关的发送器上找到此款蓝牙音乐接收器。
3. 此时设备配对并连接。连接成功后, 蓝牙音乐接收器上的 LED 灯变成蓝色并缓慢闪烁。
4. 对于某些设备要求输入配对密码, 请输入“0000”。
5. 一旦配对成功, 设备可以关闭电源, 且如需重新连接, 无需重新配对。

如已配对过:

长按蓝牙音乐接收器上的开关按钮 3 秒钟直到 LED 灯变成蓝色并闪烁。

如要关闭此设备, 长按开关按钮 5 秒钟, 此时红色 LED 长亮, 然后关闭。

注意: 请仔细阅读您的发射器或者手机的使用说明书, 找到如何使用其蓝牙无线技术

注意: 如果您想使用此蓝牙音乐接收器连接其它的发送器, 您必须从步骤 1 开始重新配对。与新的发送器配对后, 先前的发送器将不再与此音乐接收器配对, 您一次只能同时连接 1 台设备。

播放音乐

1. 使用提供的音频线和接头, 连接此蓝牙音乐接收器到您家庭音响或者车载立体设备。
2. 请确认发送器(蓝牙音频接收器, 手机 或者其它相关设备)已经开启并与蓝牙音乐接收器配对, 且设备在 10m 范围之内。
3. 蓝牙音频接收器上的 LED 灯变成蓝牙变缓慢闪烁, 这表示已经连接成功。
4. 此时播放音乐, 音乐将会通过蓝牙无线传输到蓝牙音乐接收器上。

注意: 如果您不能收听音乐:

- a) 请确保您的立体系统已经连接到
- b) 检查并确保您的音频音量没有调到最小或者静音

免提通话

1. 当你的手机默认使用蓝牙耳机麦克风时, 有电话接入时即可通过自带 MIC 实现免提通话。
2. 手机来电时, 按一下开关键即可接听语音通话。
3. 通话完成后, 自动切入手机之前的状态。
4. 断开一分钟, 该蓝牙设备将会自动关机。

指示灯显示

设备状态	LED 状态
配对或者建立连接	红色和蓝色 LED 灯同时闪烁
已连接成功且正在播放	蓝色 LED 灯每 3 秒闪烁一次
睡眠模式	蓝色 LED 灯每 5 秒闪烁一次
充电中	红色 LED 常亮
充电中且已连接	红色 LED 灯缓慢闪烁

疑难解决

蓝牙音乐接收器的连接是建立在配对完成的基础上, 连接中断可能是由于以下几个原因:

- a. 设备的间隔距离超过 33 尺 (10 米), 或者是中间有其他的障碍物 (如: 墙壁, 家具等等)
- b. 其中的一个或者两个都被关闭掉了, 也可能是因为没电了
- c. 没有在规定的时间内进行连接, 设备处于睡眠模式或者电源关闭了。关掉重新开启设备进行重新连接, 按照以下步骤操作:
 1. 重启音乐接收器和发射器。
 2. 重启后重新连接, 配对
 3. 再次给音乐接收器和发射器充上电

FCC 认证信息

我们使用于家里和办公室的音乐接收器符合 FCC 认证标准。此款设备符合 FCC 规格中的 15 条标准。设备操作是基于以下两个条件: (1) 此款设备自身可能不会造成任何的有害干扰, (2) 此款设备会接收到其它的干扰, 包括可能影响设备正常运行的干扰。

The music receiver (hands-free) is designed to receive music from mobile phones or transmitters that feature Bluetooth® wireless technology. The music receiver can be used with almost any audio receiver with an audio input jack, including automobiles. Listen to music from your smart phone or MP3 player on your existing home or car audio system. To enjoy car music, call solutions, the use of smart phones to make calls and listen to music through the car stereo. The product is embedded echo cancellation microphone. Using only one button, you can easily switch between music and phone.

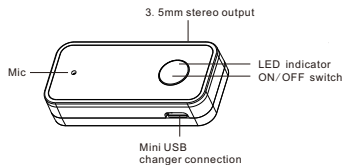

Visual Indicators

State of the device	State of the LED
Pairing or establishing a connection	The red and blue LED flash alternately
Connected and playing	The blue LED flashes once every 3 seconds
Sleep mode	The blue LED flashes once every 5 seconds
Charging	Solid red
Charging and connected	Solid red with slow flashing

Troubleshooting

The connection between the music receiver and transmitter is established once the pairing process is complete; the connection can break for the following reasons:

- The distance between the devices is greater than 33' (10m), or there are obstacles (e.g.: walls, furniture, etc.) between them.
- One or both of the devices has been turned off or must be charged.
- Connection has not been made within a specific time and the device is in sleep mode or powered off. Turn on/off both devices to re-connect or transmit audio please try the following:

Charging

- Using the supplied USB cable, connect the small end to the mini-USB input of the music receiver.
- Connect the other end to the USB input of your PC, laptop or USB power converter. The music receiver's LED light will glow red during charging.
- When charging is finished, the red LED will turn off. A full charge will provide up to 8 hours of play time.

If this is the first time you use this device, please pair this device first:

- To enter pairing mode, press and hold the on/off button for 5 seconds until both red and blue LEDs flash.
- Search for the music receiver on your mobile phone or compatible transmitter. Touch and hold one button to power on and it will automatically search for a compatible transmitter; No any codes to enter if connect with Apple or Android device; LED lights beneath the button indicate device connection and charging status.
- The devices should now recognize each other and pair. The LED on the music receiver will slowly flash blue after successful pairing.
- To complete pairing some devices require a pass

key or code, please enter "0000".

- Once successfully paired, the devices can be powered off. To re-connect simply power them both on, no need to pair again.

Note: If you wish to use the P music receiver with another transmitter you must restart the pairing process with the new device from step one. After pairing the new transmitter, the old transmitter will no longer be paired to the music receiver; you can have only one device connected at a time

If you had already matched before:

Press and hold the On/Off button for 3 seconds until the blue LED light begins flashing. To turn off, press and hold the On/Off button for 5 seconds. The red LED will light up, and then turn off. **Note:** Read the user guide of your transmitter or mobile phone to find out how to turn On/Off Bluetooth wireless technology.

Playing music

- Using the supplied audio cables and adaptors, connect the music receiver to the auxiliary (AUX) input of your home or car stereo.
- Make sure the transmitter (mini-jack, mobile

phone, or compatible source) is turned on and paired with the music receiver and that the devices are no more than 33' (10m) apart.

- The blue LED on the music receiver will flash slowly, indicating a connection.
- Press "play" and the music will be sent wireless to the music receiver.

Note: If you cannot hear the music,

- Make sure your stereo system is set to AUX input or whichever input is the corresponding input to the music receiver.
- Check and make sure the volume is not turned down or muted.

Hands-free

- Default your phone using Bluetooth microphone, telephone access to the speakerphone comes MIC.
- Phone calls, you can cut into the call status, and then press the key to open to answer a voice call.
- After the completion of the call, the phone cuts into the state before automatically.
- Disconnect after one minute, the Bluetooth device will shut down.

- Power cycle (on/off) the music receiver and transmitter.
- Power cycle and repeat pairing process for both devices.
- Recharge both devices.
